Install an antivirus program.			
Create strong passwords with numbers and letters. Don't share them.			
Avoid illegal websites for downloading. It's a crime to use them and they may have a virus.			
Do not open suspicious attachments. If you are in doubt, ask a responsible adult for help.			
Disconnect geo-tagging services except when you really need them.			
Only allow friends to see your information on Facebook.			
Check the privacy settings options on each of your apps.			
Update your browser regularly.			
Copy a URL and paste it into a browser to be sure that the link doesn't take you to a different unsafe site.
